Program Description

Spring skating programs are geared towards Rep hockey players. This is not a learn to skate program. The programs will consist of proper skating technique and mechanics. The emphasis is on teaching basic skills, agility, acceleration, edge exercises, forward and backward skating, crossovers, all turns and quick starts. Physiologically, players will develop their cardiovascular and muscular endurance, muscular strength, and power. Players will be trained how to skate with, and without the puck to enhance and develop the player's own personal style of skating.

Session Rules

Full equipment must be worn, including neck guards, otherwise you do not get on the ice. No exceptions! Students must provide their own water bottle. There will be no leaving the ice without permission from the on-ice instructor. Anyone not giving full attention, focus, and effort may be asked to leave the ice or skating school. No refund will be given for the session. No videotaping of sessions, players, or coaches is permitted on Bruno Delmaestro Sessions.

Bruno Delmaestro has a strong background in skating, having been a three-time Italian National figure skating champion, European and world competitor, and a hockey player. He has been able to transfer this success to his coaching and has been training hockey players, figure skaters and coaches for the past 40 years. He has developed his own theory and methods for teaching hockey, ringette and figure skating. He is currently a NCCP Level 4 Certified coach in Canada.

Bruno has coached many of his figure skaters to National and International medals. In 1999, 2001 and 2006 he was selected as the Competitive Coach of the Year for the British Columbia and Yukon Sections of Skate Canada.

In hockey, Bruno has trained players who have been Drafted and have played in the N.H.L., Team Canada, European, and Asian hockey leagues, W.H.L., B.C.H.L., NCAA as well as players who have been awarded university scholarships in North America. For 6 years, Bruno trained Connor Bedard, the 2023 #1 draft pick in the NHL. Bruno has been a Skate Canada Master CanPowerSkate Course Conductor and has worked with many different minor hockey associations, and academy who have used his skating programs.

Bruno is undoubtedly considered one of the best in the field by many hockey coaches, players, and parents.
